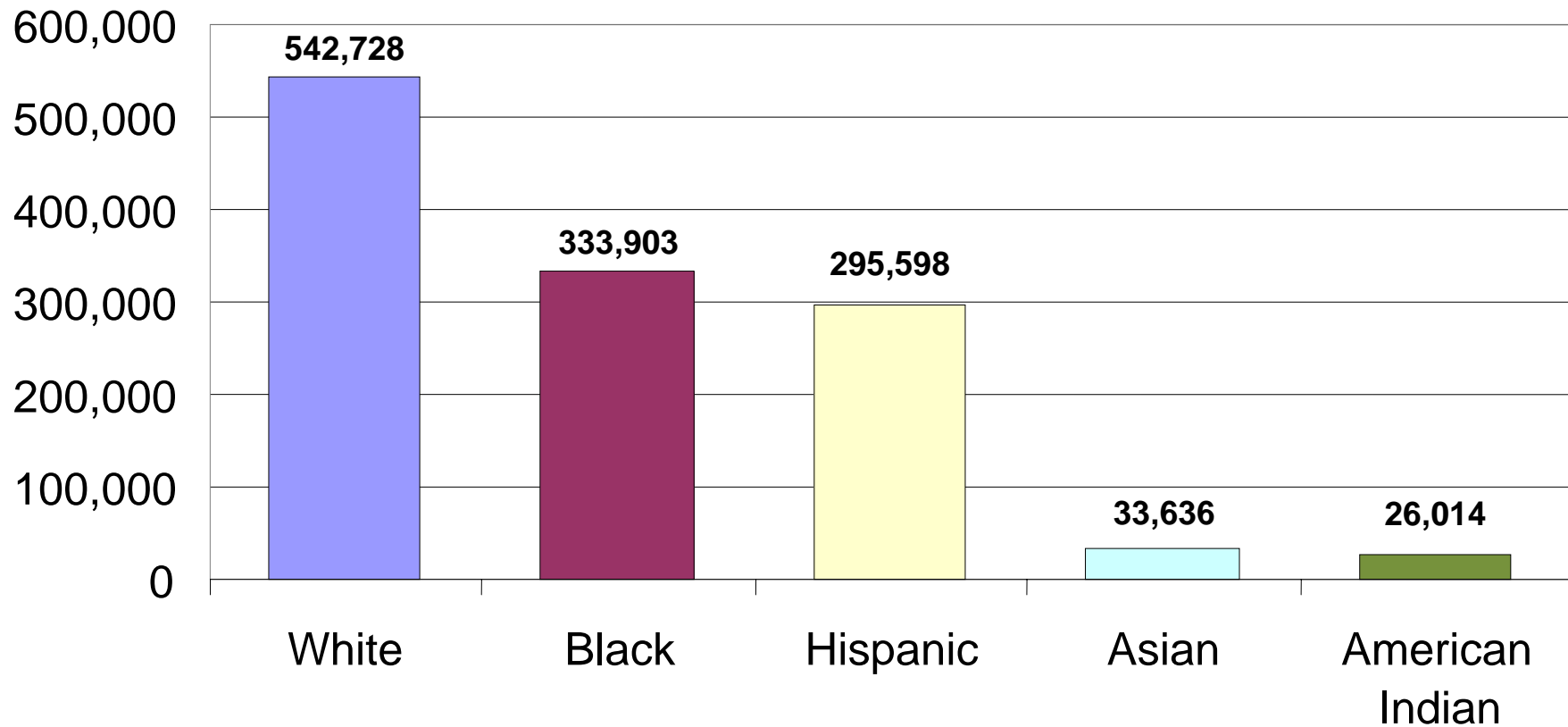

Number of Nongraduates by Race and Ethnicity

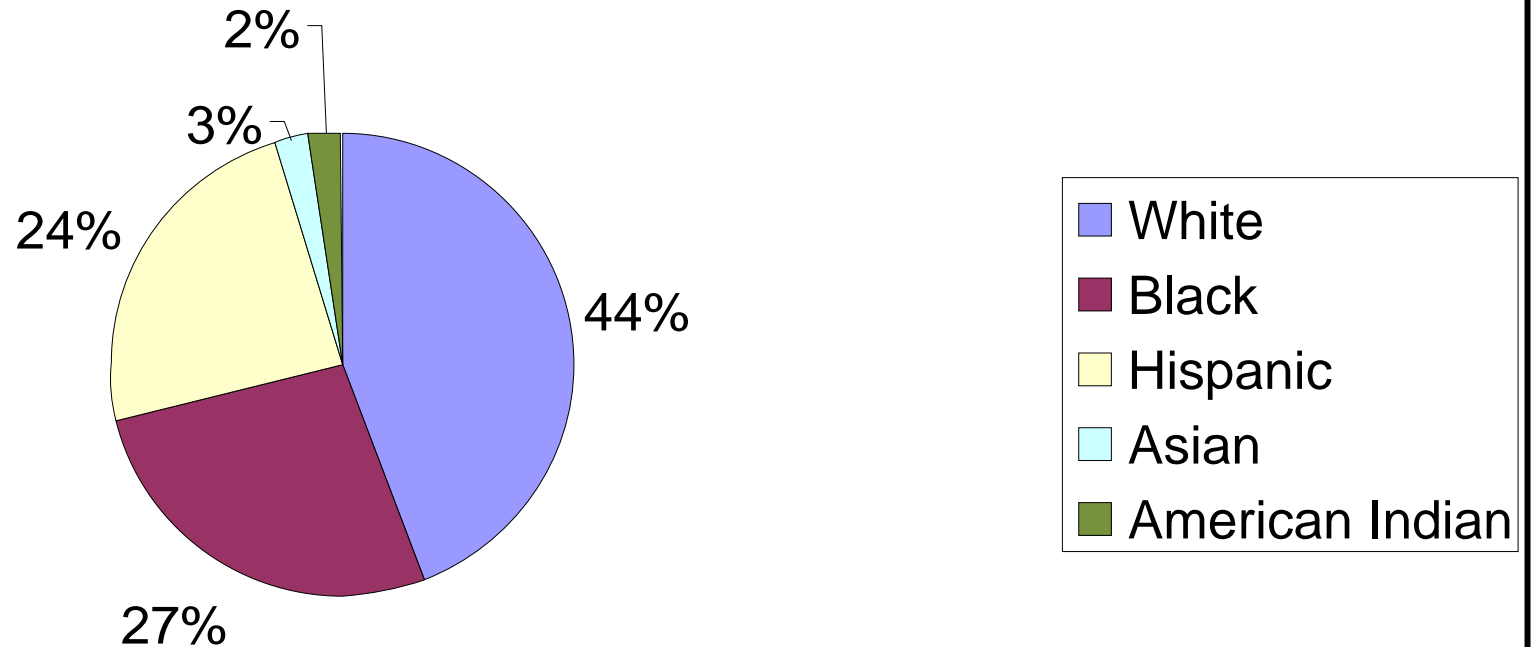

Racial and Ethnic Groups as a Percentage of Nongraduates

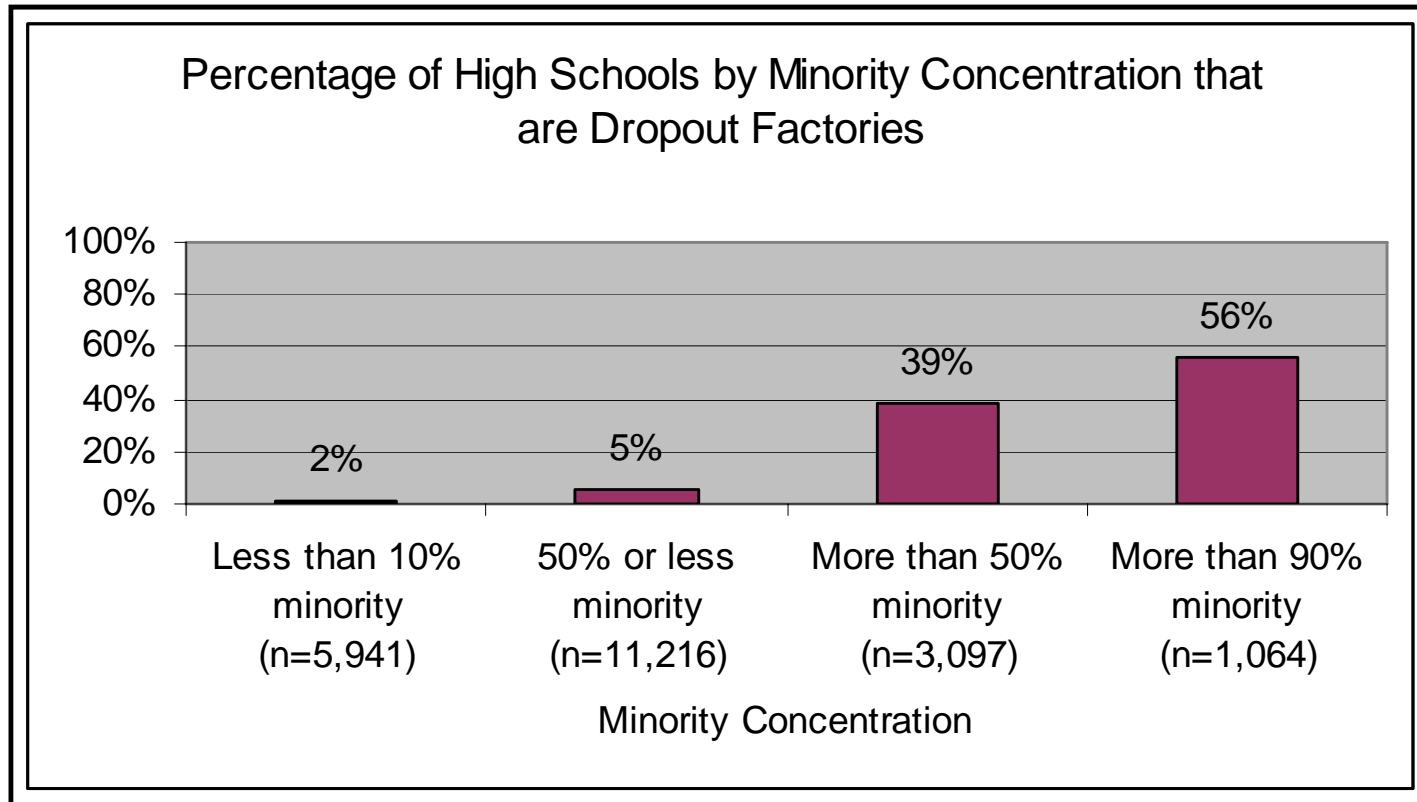

Dropout Factories and Minority Concentration

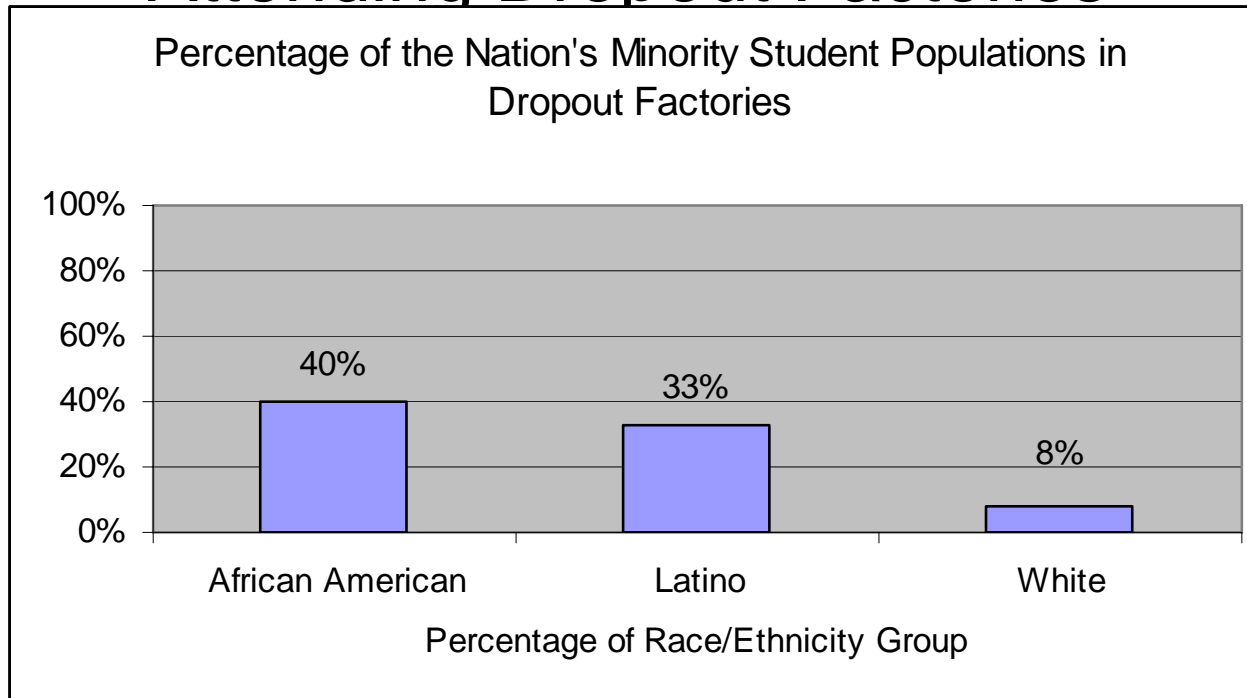

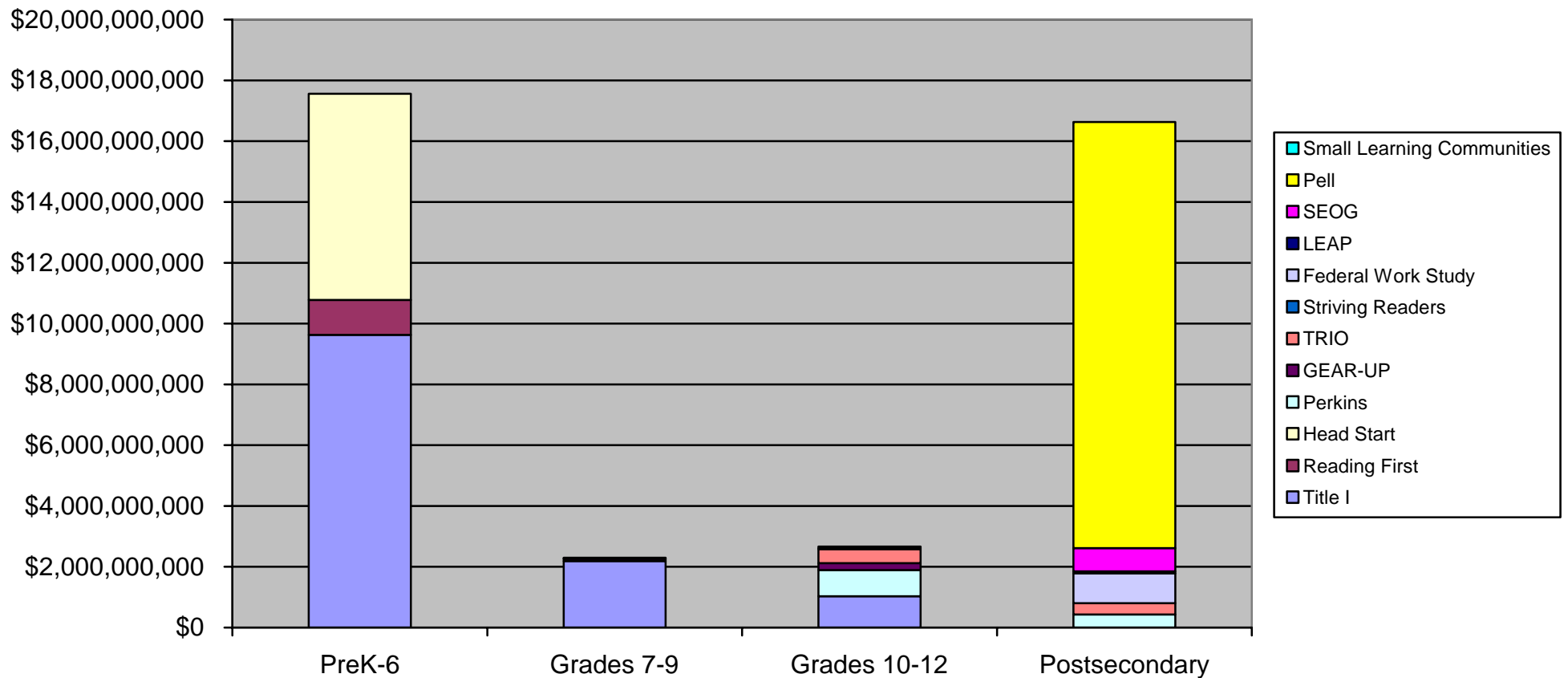
Percent of Minority Students Attending Dropout Factories
